## VIA DEGLI DEI - PATH ADJUSTMENTS

Variations required due to landslides – Updates on 27/5/2023.

All the following indications refer to the official map of the path that we recommend using during the walk. Setting off with all the correct information is the first step to a satisfying journey.

From Bologna go up to the Madonna di San Luca, after the Basilica continue the road regularly and after about 500 meters you reach the path of Bregoli that descends to Parco Talon (Casalecchio di Reno).

In the lower part, however, the path is affected by some landslides, so it is not accessible.

After a few hundreds of meters on the left there is the path **CAI 900** which is to be taken following new indications and signs that have been placed. This will lead you to the Parco Talon. (marked in BLUE on the official map image1).


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Image 1 - Bregoli variant - CAI path 900 Parco Talon

Track GPX 1 (CAI900-Bregoli) – for those equipped with gps readers.

Given the persistence of the mud, we suggest following the Via della Lana e della Seta then, once you arrive at the blue pedestrian iron bridge, cross the river, and take the orographic left of the Reno (in the map guide indicated as VLS, Via della Lana e della Seta). Once you reach Palazzo de' Rossi you can either continue the Via della Lana e della Seta path if you're planning to stop in Sasso Marconi or Cross the Vizzano bridge and return on the original Via degli Dei path if You need to reach Prati di Mugnano / Badolo / Brento.

Once you arrive on the main road (when Via Vizzano joins the SP 37, known as via delle Ganzole) turn right. Take the path with the variations (indications in BLUE on the cartography officer – figure 2) to arrive at Prati di Mugnano.



After at least 500 meters You reach the location named Piazza: <u>do not follow the old path</u> as it has been interrupted by a huge landslide; take instead the CAI path 118A (marked in BLUE on the official map – figure 3). Further on you will find yourself again in front of a landslide, but just before on the left there is a path with the new CAI signs which will lead you to the locality of the Commenda where you can resume the path along Via delle Orchidee.




Image 3 - Prati di Mugnano area , from Piazza to Commenda

GPX Track 2 (Piazza-Commenda) – for those with gps readers.

From Via delle Orchidee, you pass in front of the Nova Arbora B&B and continue on the way. Once you pass the "Centro Tutela e Ricerca Fauna Esotica e Selvatica" <u>do not turn right</u> but keep going forward on the MTB variant (marked in BLUE on nyhe official map – figure 4). If instead you'll be staying at the Piccola Raieda Farmhouse continue following the Via degli Dei Path and return the day after following the previous indications on the MTB variation.

The loop going up to Monte Adone is interrupted by a large landslide and is not possible now to climb the top of the mountain.

Once you arrive in Brento you continue the regular route, we just point out that between Monterumici and Monzuno some stretches of the path are being set up and now, for safety, it is better to take the paved road.

From Montuno up to Florence there are no reports of major difficulties but only small landslides that can be overcome.

All the variants are already indicated by new CAI signs.
